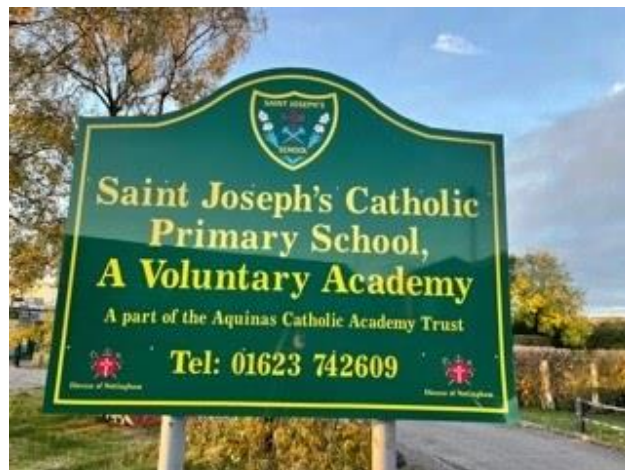

Nativity Dates

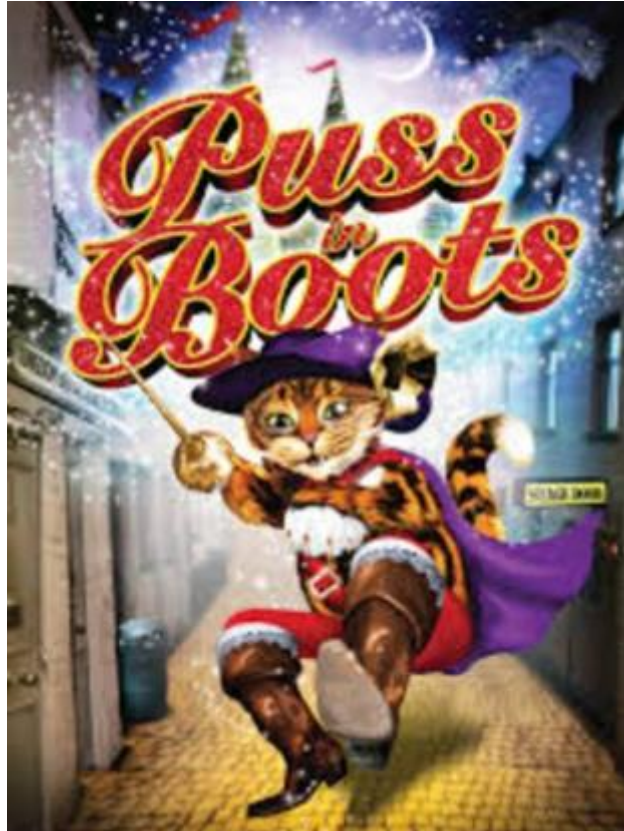
