

# i-Vengers

A few weeks ago, our i-vengers sent a survey to children and parents regarding internet safety. The i-venger team has analyzed the responses and would like to share some of the results and common trends.

The survey revealed that some children were spending more than 6 hours online and a small minority were accessing games that were not suitable for primary children. For example, Grand Theft Auto (Pegi rating 18) and Fortnite (Pegi rating 12).

The survey also revealed that some children knew how to get around parental controls, how to download games and often went on devices when they knew they should be asleep.

The i-vengers would therefore like to remind parents to speak to their children about how much time they spend online and which games they are playing.

The i-vengers are going to be continuing their fabulous work ensuring that our children are safe online and will be going around classes to give ideas to reduce the amount of time children spend online.
