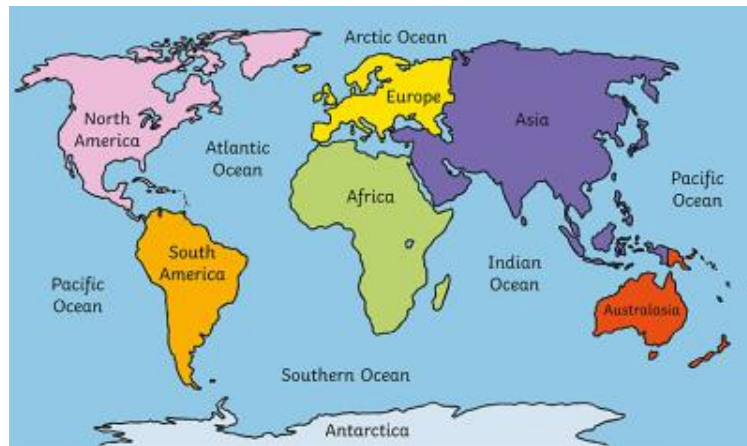


Moon Zoom: Geography Knowledge Organiser

The UK is part of the continent of Europe.

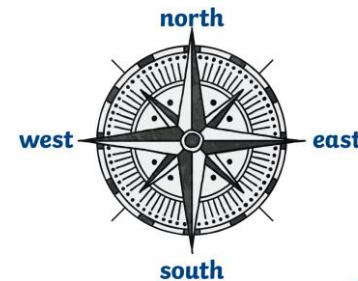
Climates around the world
