## PE and sport

This term PE will take place on a **Thursday**. Please can all children wear their PE kit to school on this day.

### Topic - Growing

This term we will be thinking about how things grow. We will be reflecting on how we have grown and changed. We will introduce the children to life cycles of humans, animals and plants. We will be reading A Growing Story, The Hungry Caterpillar, We Found A Seed and many more books within this Topic!

### **Phonics**

This term we will introduce a Phase 2 grapheme daily. The children will recognise and write the graphemes whilst blending it into words orally. We will continue practicing how to write our name using correct pencil grip.

### <u>Maths</u>

This term we will be learning how to match objects and pictures, exploring how to sort objects to a type and comparing amounts of objects.

#### Reminders

### Ways to help with learning at home this term

Phonics is a vital part in your child's learning and development. Please help your child practice their Phonic as much as possible using the Little Wandle flash cards provided. Each week we will send home an information sheet of what we have learnt in Phonics that week.

Each child must read their Little Wandle book 3 times a week. Parents are encouraged to share and read the 'book for pleasure' alongside this.

We will be launching Numberbots within the term to support with Maths at home. More information to follow!
