

Children in years 4-6 went to church for Reconciliation this week.

What have we been up to this week?

Nursery- The children have been learning how to count to 5.

Reception- The children have been reading the story of, 'The Little Red Hen' and have been learning about how caring is sharing.

Year One- The children have been learning about subtraction and learning about how Florence Nightingale started a school to train nurses.

Year Two- The children have been learning different ways that we prepare during Advent in their RE lessons.

Year Three- The children have been learning about subtraction when crossing 10 and about hunters and gatherers in history.

Year Four-The children have been learning about classification keys of plants and animals in science.

Year Five- The children have been learning about equivalent fractions in maths.

Year Six- The children have been learning about the prophets expectations of Jesus in RE.

Attendance

Whole school attendance this week is 95.7%

Reception- 97.6%

Year One - 92.3 %

Year Two - 98.2% Year Three-97.2% Year Four- 91.3% Year Five- 96.5% Year Six-97.1%

Well done to Year 2 who have won our attendance award this week! They will enjoy our new reward for this term, Fresh Air Friday.

Attending school every day = 100% attendance

Attending 4½ days a week = 90% attendance = 4 weeks missed per year

Attending 4 days a week = 80% attendance = more than half a term missed per year.

Attending 3½ days each week = 70% attendance = more than a quarter of the school year missed.

An average attendance of 80% or less across a child's school career adds up to **missing a whole 2 years from school.**

Advent Art Evening

We are really excited to have an Advent Art evening booked in school on Wednesday 18th December from 3:45- 5:45. This is open to all pupils in key stage 2 (years 3-6). The evening will be led by an artist, Jo Bell, who has worked in school before painting a mural in the corridor and canvases for classrooms. During the evening, Jo will teach the children step by step how to create an advent picture on an individual canvas. At the end of the session, each child will be able to take their art work home.

This is an amazing opportunity for our children to learn from a real artist and create a beautiful canvas to take home.

The cost for the evening is £10 per child. This includes the cost of their painting materials and canvas as well as juice and biscuits during the evening.

If your child was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021 you should apply for their infant or primary school place by 15 January 2025. You'll be able to apply from 11 November 2024. To apply for your place you need to apply via your home council.
