

Catholic Life and Mission

Another wonderful week for Catholic Life and Mission at St Joseph's. On Wednesday, year 2 led the whole school in prayer and today, years 1 and 6 led a wonderful Celebration of the word in church.

Our CAFOD club organised a donations box for our RE gallery, this will be added to our Lent collection.

Years 5 and 6 went on their, 'Big Lent Walk' to raise money for CAFOD.

Next week, we will be thinking about the events of Holy Week in class and in whole school worship. Years 4 and 5 will present the events of Holy Week at 2pm on Friday 4th April.

What have we been up to this week at St Joseph's?

The children in Nursery have been reading, 'The Gingerbread Man' and have been learning about letter and number formation.

Reception- The children have been looking at recipes and how they can make their own gingerbread men.

Year One- The children have been learning about Neil Armstrong and have been writing biographies.

Year Two- The children have been learning about division in their maths work.

Year Three- The children have been learning about unit fractions in maths and about the Ancient Greek Olympics in history.

Year Five- The children have been learning about how we can sacrifice things during Lent inspired by Jesus.

Attendance

Whole school attendance this week is 95.8%

Reception- 93.1%

Year One - 97.1%

Year Two - 91.3%

Year Three-99.1%

Year Four- 95.5%

Year Five- 95.6%

Year Six- 98.5%

Well done to year 3 who won our attendance award this week and enjoyed an extra playtime.

Attending school every day = 100% attendance

Attending 4½ days a week = 90% attendance = 4 weeks missed per year

Attending 4 days a week = 80% attendance = more than half a term missed per year.

Attending 3½ days each week = 70% attendance = more than a quarter of the school year missed.

An average attendance of 80% or less across a child's school career adds up to missing a whole 2 years from school.
