

#### **Attendance**

Whole school attendance this week is 95.2%. Thank you for your support, attendance across school has improved this week.

Reception- 96.7%

Year One - 91.3%

Year Two - 95.7%

Year Three-97.5%

Year Four- 91.6%

Year Five- 97%

Year Six- 100%

Well done to year 6 and year 3 who won our attendance award this week and enjoyed an extra playtime.

Attending school every day = 100% attendance

Attending 4½ days a week = 90% attendance = 4 weeks missed per year

Attending 4 days a week = 80% attendance = more than half a term missed per year.

Attending 3½ days each week = 70% attendance = more than a quarter of the school year missed.

An average attendance of 80% or less across a child's school career adds up to **missing a whole 2 years from school.**
