

## Head Pupils



Our Head Pupils have been busy this week reviewing their action plan and thinking about what they want to achieve this year.

**Article of the week- this is an opportunity for the children to look at different articles from the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC).**

This week the children have been thinking about Article 14- Freedom of thought and religion

## What have we been up to this week at St Joseph's?

Nursery- The children have been exploring lights and shadows and have been practicing their letter formation and drawing.

Reception- The children have been learning about part whole models in maths.

Year One- The children have been learning about UK flags and have been learning about proper nouns in English.

Year Two- The children have been thinking about what animals and humans need to survive.

Year Three- The children have been learning about linking adverbs in English and multiplication in maths.

Year Six- The children have been learning about evacuees in WWII in their new history topic.

## Attendance

Whole school attendance this week is **89.8%**. Attendance is slightly slower this week due to the bad weather last Friday. We are hopeful that attendance will improve next week.

**Year 1- 96.7%**

**Year 2- 88.4%**

**Year 3- 83.5%**

**Year 4- 93.9%**

**Year 5- 91.6%**

**Year 6- 87.9%**

**Well done to year 1 this week who have won our attendance award this week and enjoyed Fresh Air Friday!**

Attending school every day = 100% attendance

Attending 4½ days a week = 90% attendance = **4 weeks missed per year**

Attending 4 days a week = 80% attendance = **more than half a term missed per year.**

Attending 3½ days each week = 70% attendance = **more than a quarter of the school year missed.**

An average attendance of 80% or less across a child's school career adds up to **missing a whole 2 years from school.**
